

## Frenchay Holdings, Stoke Lane, Frenchay, Bristol.

LOCATION: The site is located off Stoke Lane, Frenchay.

DESCRIPTION: An area of grazing land extending to approximately 5.88 hectares

(14.5 acres) shown outlined in red on the plan overleaf. Access to the

site will be permitted over the land coloured brown.

TENURE: A Grazing Tenancy will be available for a period of 3 months certain.

Thereafter, the agreement shall continue quarter to quarter until either party serves to the other a written notice of 3 months to terminate the

agreement.

USE: The grazing of horses only.

LAND CONDITION: Large grazing area which includes an area of woodland. The

proposed tenant may need to carry out some works to make the site stock proof. The Council would allow the proposed tenant on site under and 'Indemnity Notice' to prepare and make ready before

occupation.

SERVICES: No services on site.

COSTS: The successful applicant will be required to make a contribution

towards the City Council's surveyors and legal costs.

SUBMISSION: Sealed bids are invited and should include the following:

a) Offer of rental

b) Details of proposed use
